3. The IVR system will be updated with a recorded message that if Casuals wish to Plug-In they can do so online or by calling an ILWU Dispatch Coordinator.
4. Casuals who Plug-In and wish to Un-Plug prior to the above Plug-In end times, will be able to do so online. Casuals who Plug-In and wish to Un-Plug after the above Plug-In end times must call the ILWU Dispatch Coordinator.
5. Casuals will be required to pick up their slip online and attend the appropriate site for the appropriate start time. Casuals must be in proximity to the waterfront in order to ensure that they arrive at their work start time.
6. If a Casual has been dispatched to a position whereas there is a requirement for a beard check, they will be contacted to verify they meet the eligibility requirements.
7. Casuals must not attend the Hall, except to: get a cab to a worksite; obtain PPE (where applicable); obtain a Port Pass; 11:50 dispatch; or pick up their pay cheque.
8. For late calls for Casuals, the Coordinators will contact the Casuals, and then BCMEA will dispatch.
9. Casuals will call 604-800-6426 or 604-216-0356 between 4:45 pm - 6:00 pm to sign up for 01:00 late replacements.
