**Issue: Coronavirus disease (COVID-19)**

### **Purpose**

This **Marine Security Notification (MSN)** provides an update to MSN #2020-006 issued on March 27, 2020, which is hereby rescinded.

Transport Canada (TC) continues to monitor the evolving public health threat of the COVID-19, both internationally and nationally, with a view of mitigating its effect on Canada's maritime transportation system.

### **Direction and Guidance**





In the event that PHAC determines a crew member or passenger onboard a vessel to be at risk, notification will be provided to other organizations (this may include but is not limited to the CBSA, CCG, TC Marine Safety, and appropriate pilotage and port authorities).

Should a vessel have an ill or symptomatic crew member or passenger after having arrived in Canada, vessel operators should inform the appropriate local health authority



on location and nature of the vessel's work, which may include marine communications and traffic services, pilotage authorities, port authority, and marine facility operators).
